- KCLS Manager's Report
 - The Shoreline Library will be closed for remodeling from April 16 through May 20, 2018, to create a teen space, replace carpeting, reconfigure seating, move shelving, and update electrical options. The meeting room will remain open to pick up holds and to return library materials. Denise plans an after-hours open house in September to show school officials and students the new space.
 - Dates to remember:

 - May 28 all libraries will be closed for Memorial Day
 - Author J. A. Jance will appear at the Covington Library on April 5 from 7-9 pm, the Federal Way Library on April 12 from 7-8:30 pm, and the Burien Library on April 13 from 2-4 pm.
 - KCLS Director Lisa Rosenblum has reported that the KCLS Foundation raised more than \$487,000 at this year's annual Literary Lions Gala on March 11. The money raised will be used to expand library programs such as the new IdeaX MakerSpace at the Bellevue Library (opening April 14). KCLS is one of only eight libraries nationwide to receive a grant from the Urban Libraries Council to participate in its Entrepreneurship Peer Learning Cohort. This program is designed to explore new approaches to reaching and engaging potential entrepreneurs, particularly people of color, women, immigrants, and veterans. Denise plans to explore the possibility of local programming to support this grant. Finally, the Tukwila Library was selected as a finalist for a 2018 Sustainability Leadership Award by the conservation organization, Sustainable Seattle.
