- KCLS Manager's Report
 - Deirdre reported that Library Journal awarded the King County Library System 5 stars on its annual Index of Public Library Service, one of only five libraries in its category (libraries with annual expenditures exceeding \$30 million).
 - As part of a partnership with King County Elections, KCLS has ballot drop boxes at 18 of its libraries. The library drop boxes accounted for 23.11% (over 89,000 ballots) of all ballots returned to the boxes. 7,708 ballots were returned to the box at the Lake Forest Park City Hall. Several KCLS branches hosted candidate forums and voter information tables sponsored by the League of Women Voters.
 - Now that the Lake Forest Branch has a new children's librarian, Julie Hiers, there has been more children's programming. Attendance is rising at adult and teen programming as well.
