

# Thank you for licensing your pet

## A RASKC pet license includes many benefits:

- Vacation Pet Alert:** The program allows you to provide the pet licensing office with your pet caretaker contact information when you are away, so that the correct person can be contacted if the pet is found away from home. Register by calling 206-296-2712.
- Lost Pet:** If your pet becomes lost their finder can call the number on the pet license tag **24 hours a day, seven days a week** to obtain your contact information for a quick reunion. Visit our website at [kingcounty.gov/pets](http://kingcounty.gov/pets) to see a list of lost pets that are at the shelter as well as adoptable pets.
- Free Ride Home:** Lost pets wearing a license when found by an Animal Control Officer will be delivered to your home for free (first time).
- Is your pet microchipped?** Enter the number at the time you license or by calling 206-296-2712 and we will store it in your pet's licensing record for added protection should they become lost.
- Saving Lives!** Protect not only your pet, but thousands of other pets in the community. License revenues support RASKC's Animal Care and Control program that provides shelter and care for thousands of stray and abandoned cats and dogs each year; supports rescue, foster, adoption and medical care and treatment for our animals; provides animal control enforcement services to unincorporated King County and 24 partner cities.
- If the time comes when your pet should be humanely euthanized, you can bring your pet to the RASKC Animal Shelter in Kent.
