## Kenmore and Lake Forest Park Recycling Collection Event

**Saturday, October 8, 2022 9 am to 3 pm**



### Only the Following Items Will be Accepted.....

- **TIRES:** Limit 6 passenger tires per household (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for all passenger tires on rims. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (*cash only*). No oversized tires accepted.
- **LEAD ACID BATTERIES:** Car, truck, marine, motorcycle, and sealed lead acid batteries accepted.
- **ALKALINE BATTERIES:** AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. No rechargeable, cell phone, or nicad batteries accepted. Lithium-ion batteries, like tool and vape batteries, will not be accepted.

• **ELECTRONIC/COMPUTER EQUIPMENT:** DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, and cellular phones (**remove personal information**). Computers and computer monitors (**no charge**), mouse, keyboards, tablet computers, and e-readers.

• **TELEVISION SETS:** TV sets encased in plastic, wood console, sets encased in wood, and big screen TVs accepted (**no charge**).

• **CONFIDENTIAL DOCUMENT SHREDDING:** Shredding and recycling of confidential paper materials. Limit 4 file-size boxes. No exceptions.

• **PROPANE TANKS:** Residential tanks only. \$5 (*cash only*).

• **PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS:** Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed. \$15 charge (*cash only*).

• **REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS:** \$30 (*cash only*) for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (*cash only*) for each household air conditioner. Please be prepared to pay at event entrance.

• **APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL:** Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (**drained of oil and gasoline**), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. \$5 or each water heater that still has insulation coating (*cash only*). Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted.

• **BULKY WOOD:** Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. No peg board, particle or press board. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.

• **MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS:** Mattresses and box springs, any size. \$20 (*cash only*) per mattress and \$20 (*cash only*) per box spring. Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.

**PLEASE NOTE: HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND CLOTHING will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to donation locations in the local area. CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM LOCATIONS ARE OPEN AND ACCEPTING MATERIAL.**

**PLEASE ALSO NOTE: STYROFOAM BLOCKS AND PACKING PEANUTS will not be accepted. This material can be self hauled to Styro Recycle located at 23418 68th Ave S, Kent, WA - (253) 838-9555. Check out <http://www.styrorecycle.com>.**

No paint of any kind  
No pesticides/herbicides  
No household chemicals  
No cleaning products  
No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes can be taken to the Household Hazardous Wastemobile or household hazardous waste collection sites in North Seattle and Bellevue (Factoria). **North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility is located at 12550 Stone Ave N, Seattle, WA 98133. Hours: Sunday–Tuesday, 9:00 am – 5:00 pm. Closed on major holidays.** Containers must be five gallons in size or smaller. Customers can have gas containers back upon request. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. **No latex paint is accepted.** See [www.paintcare.org/wa](http://www.paintcare.org/wa) for more information on paint collection.

Use E-Cycle Washington sites for computers, computer monitors, laptops, tablets, TVs, portable DVD players, and E-readers. Call 1-800-RECYCLE or visit [ecyclewa.org](http://ecyclewa.org) to find authorized E-Cycle Washington collection locations. You may drop off E-Cycle items at no charge at the following locations: St. Vincent de Paul (7304 Bothell Way, Kenmore, WA, 98028, 425-483-9497, note: televisions must be 25" or smaller) and Goodwill Shoreline Store (14500 15th Avenue NE Shoreline, WA, 98105, 206 631-8454. Drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted may be limited. Please also note that computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.
